

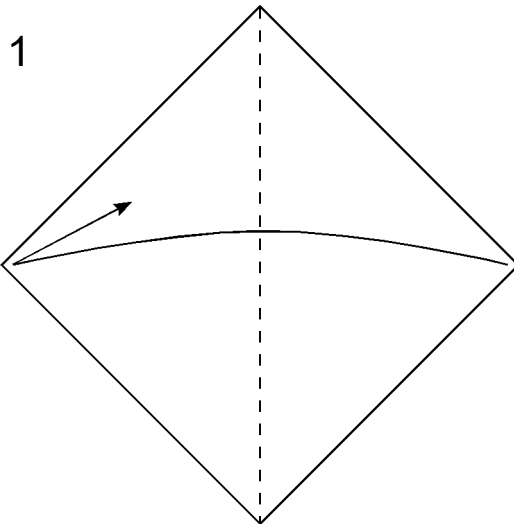
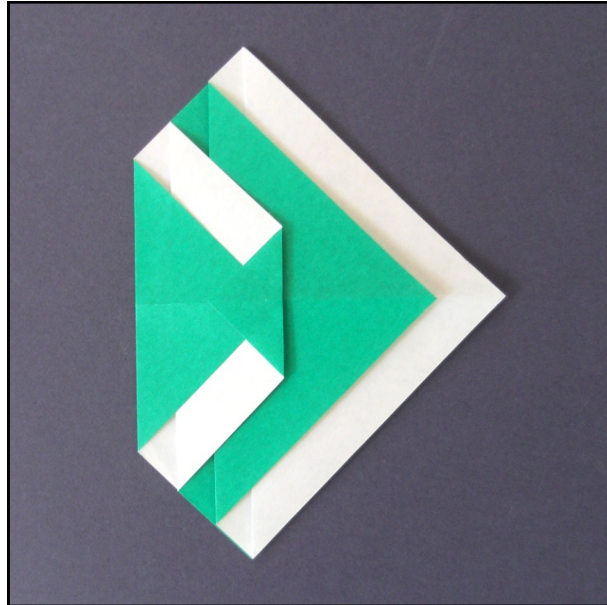
Fishwife

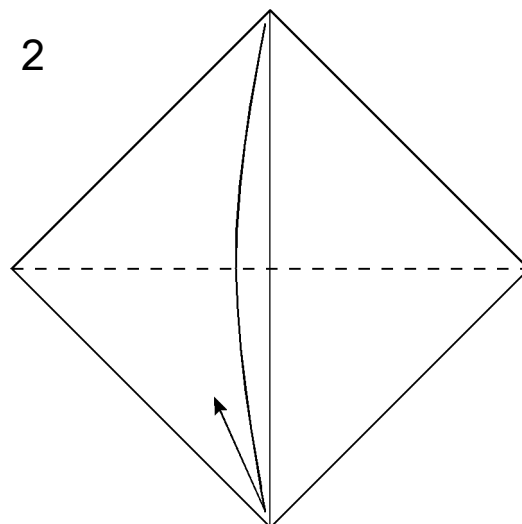
Fishwife is a double image pictorial design in which a simple image of a fish is turned, using one extra fold, into an image of a woman, or wife.

Fishwife was developed in 2018 from my Find the Lady puzzle.

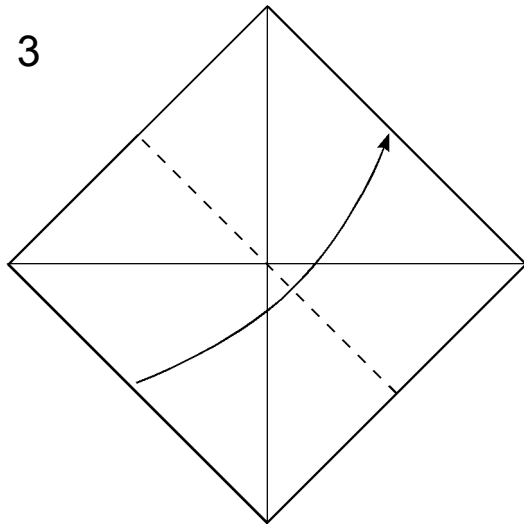
You will need a single square of irogami. Begin with your paper arranged white side up.



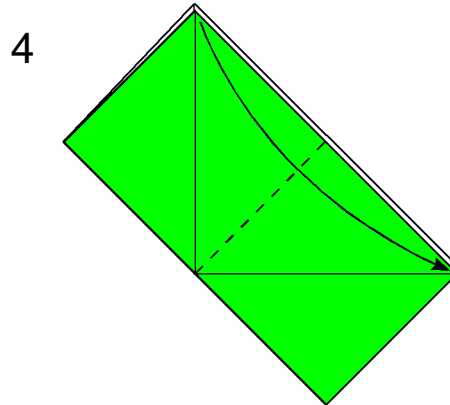
1. Fold in half diagonally, then unfold.



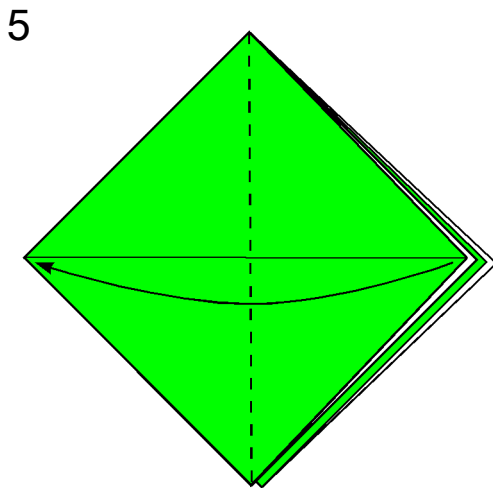
2. Fold in half diagonally in the other direction, then unfold.



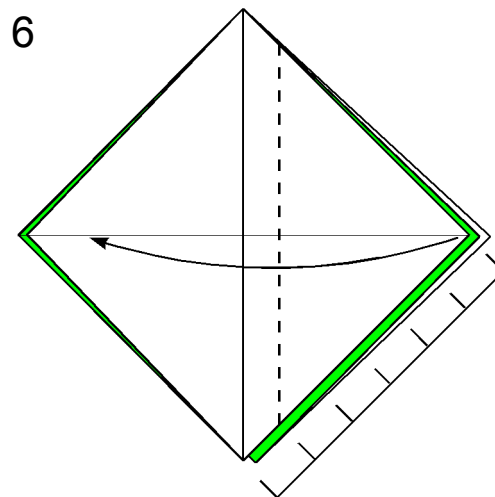
3. Fold in half diagonally edge to edge as shown..



4. Fold in half edge to edge in the other direction as shown.

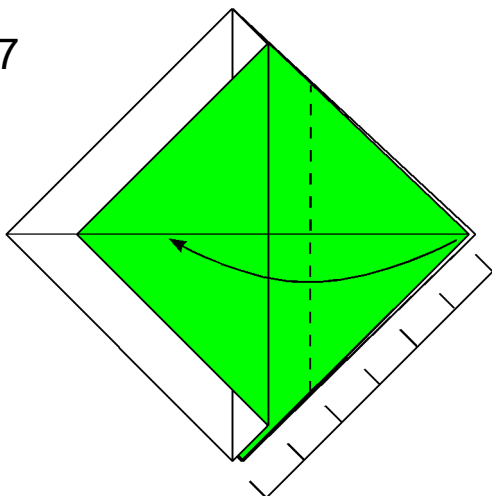


5. Fold the right corner of the front layer across to the left.



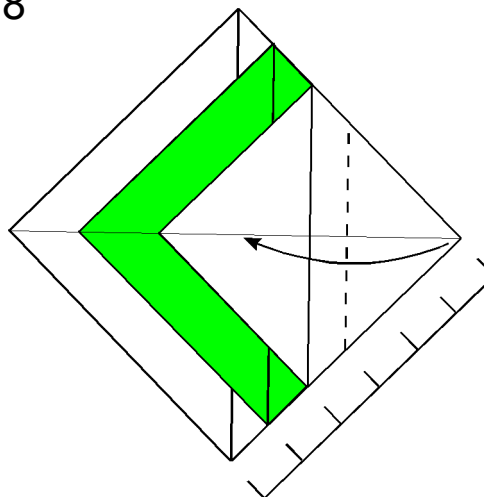
6. Fold the right corner of the next layer across to the left as well so that it lands on the central crease about five sixths of the way across.

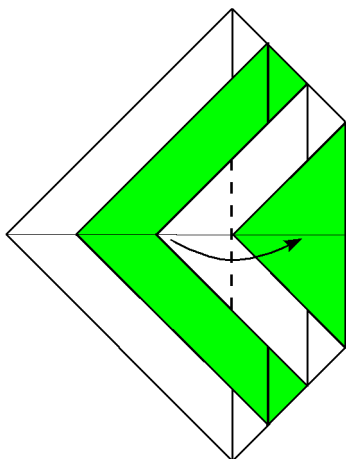
7. Do the same thing again ...

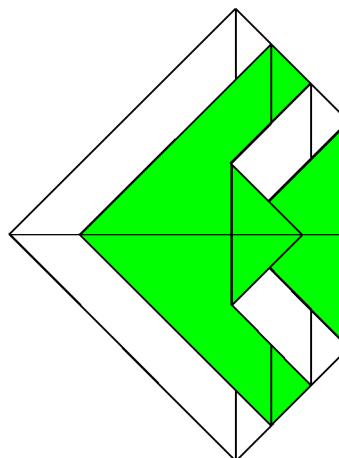
8. ... and again.

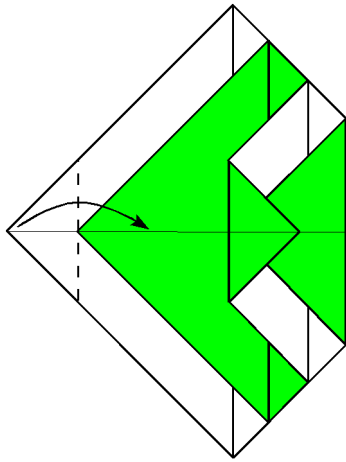
9. Fold the left point of the second to top layer across to the right like this.

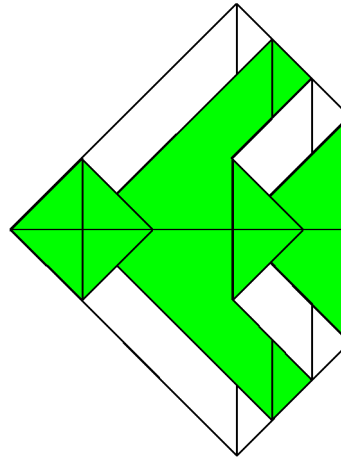
10. This is the fish.

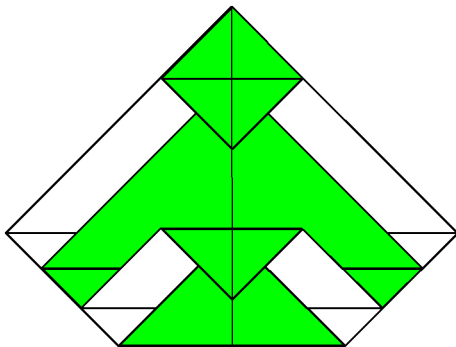
11. Fold the left corner across to the right like this.
