

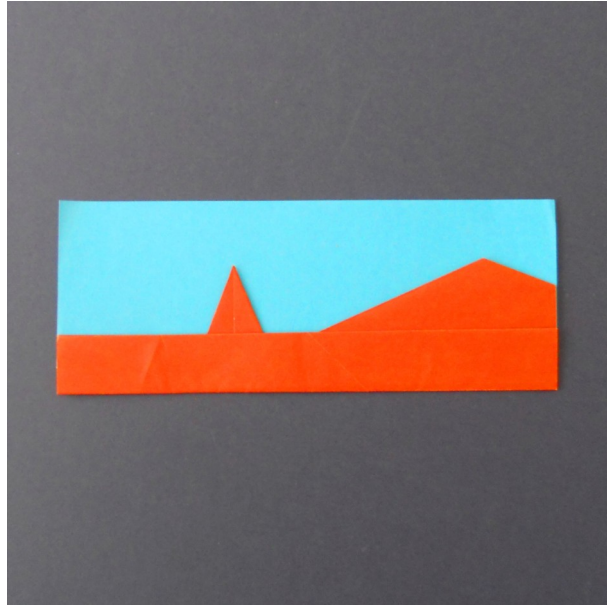
# Indian Country

Indian Country is one of a series of pictorial landscapes originally designed for my book *Origami Alfresco*. It can be classed as a surprise denouement design since the subject is not clear until the finished design is turned over in step 17.

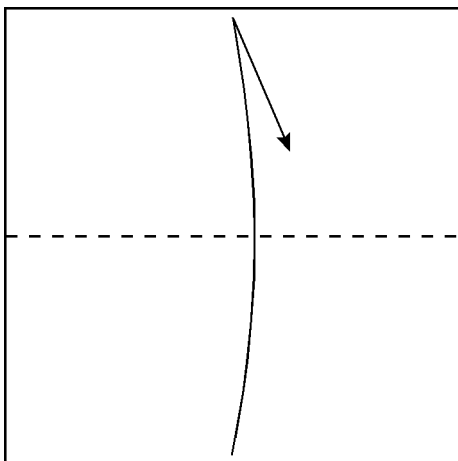
Indian Country was designed in 2006.

You will need a single square of irogami in a suitable colour.



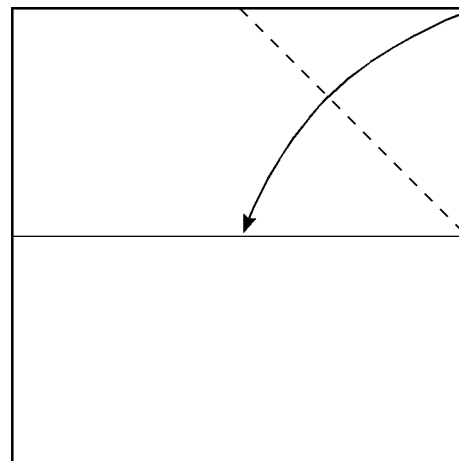
Begin with your paper arranged white side up.

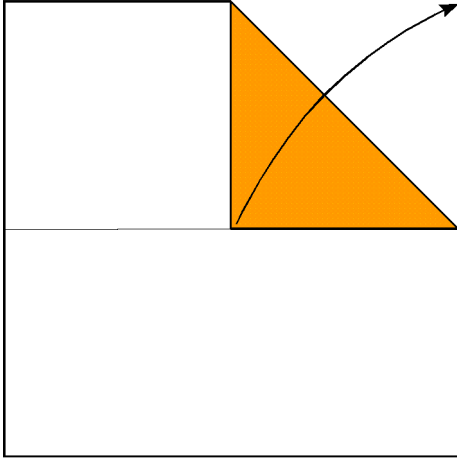
1. Fold in half upwards, then unfold.

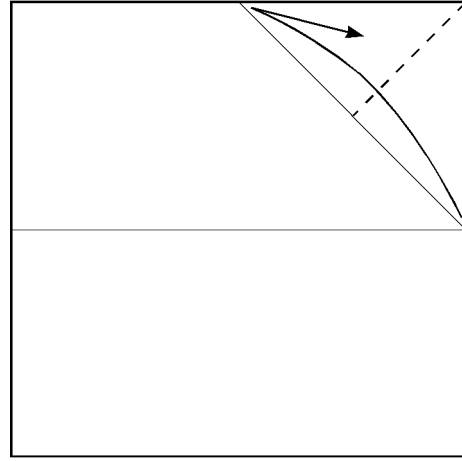
2. Fold the top right hand corner into the centre using the crease made in step 1 as a guide.

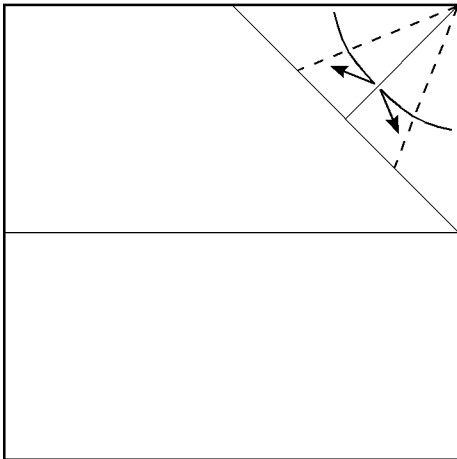
3. Open out.

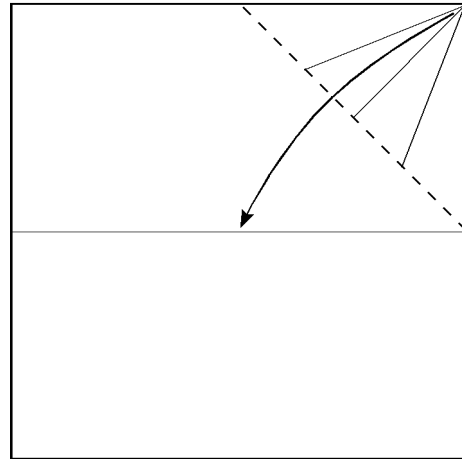
4. Crease in part of one diagonal as shown.

5. Fold both edges adjacent to the top right hand corner onto the diagonal crease, then unfold.

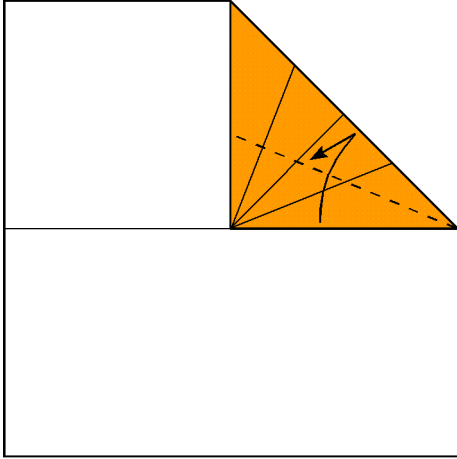


6. Remake the fold made in step 2 using the existing crease.

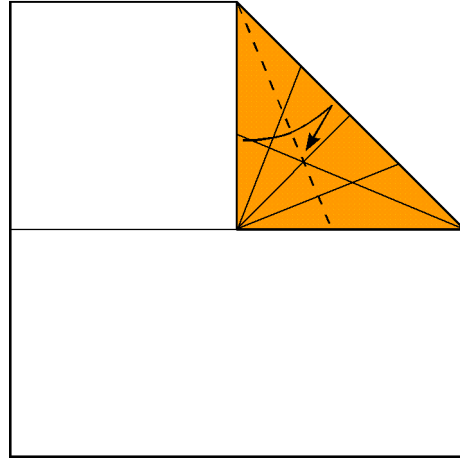

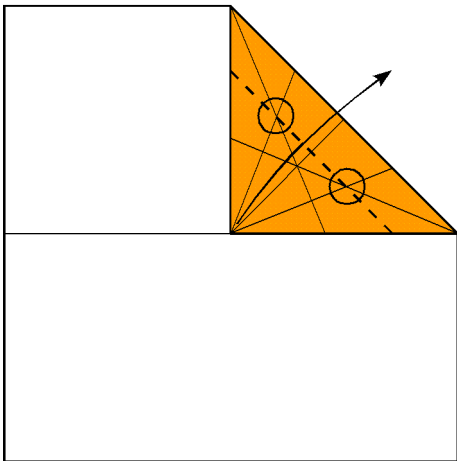
7. Fold the bottom edge of the coloured triangle onto the sloping edge, then unfold.

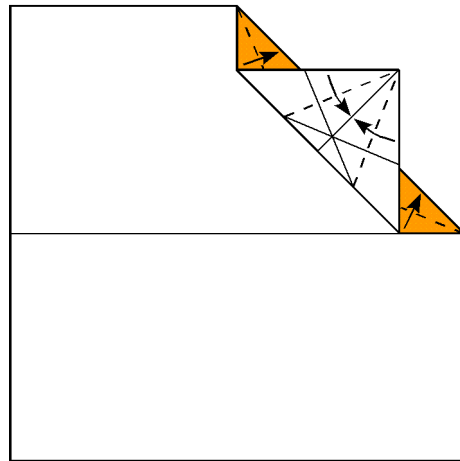
8. Do the same thing with the upright edge of the coloured triangle.

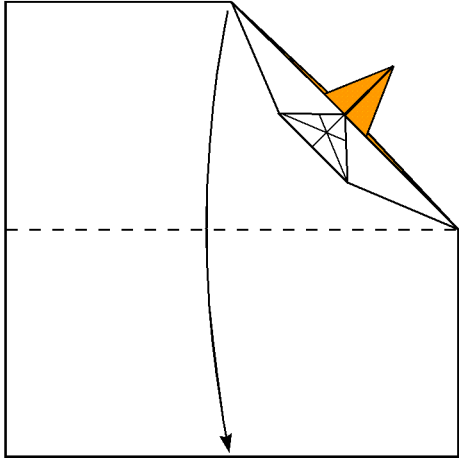
9. Fold the point of the coloured triangle outwards using the intersections of the creases made in the previous steps to locate the crease accurately.

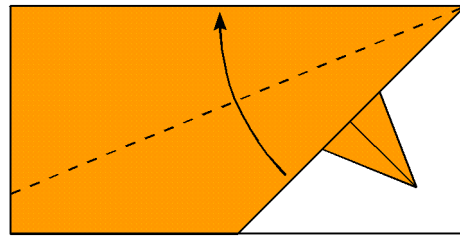
10. Fold the top and right hand edges of the white triangle inwards using the existing creases and flatten symmetrically.

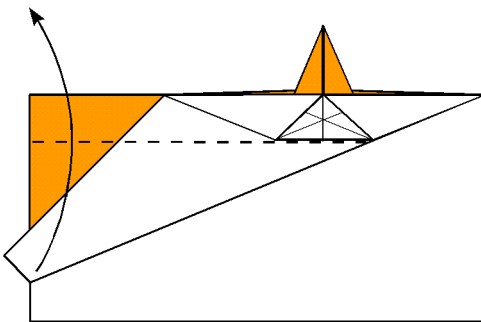
11. Fold in half downwards using the crease made in step 1.

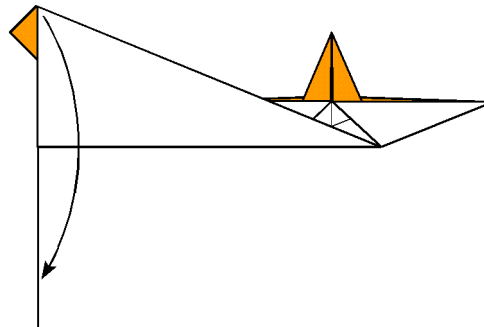
12. Fold the diagonal edge of the coloured area onto the top edge.

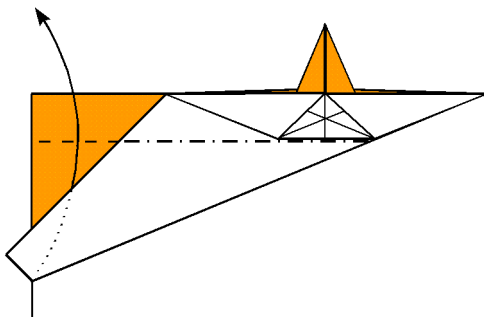
13. Fold the middle layers upwards along a line just below the bottom of the front layers.

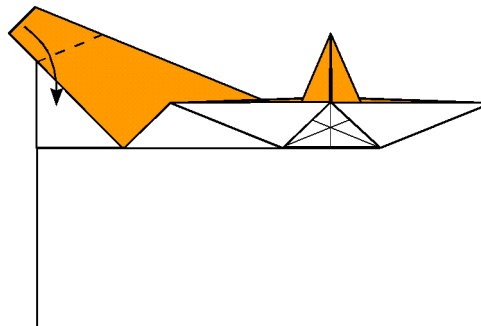
14. Undo the last fold.

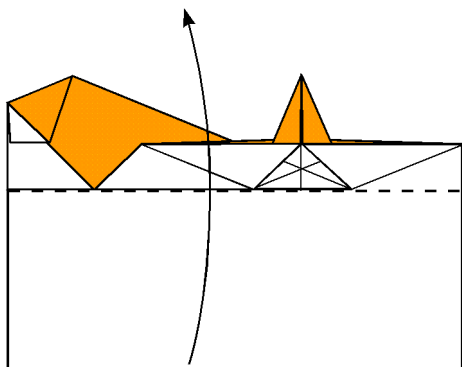
15. Turn the middle layers inside out between the other layers using the creases made in step 13.

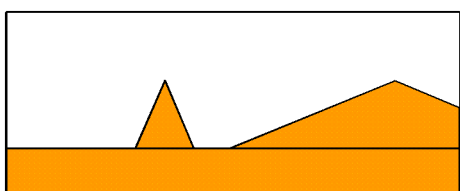
16. Fold the tip of the top left hand corner inwards so that the left hand edges are aligned.

17. Fold the bottom edge upwards along a line just below the edge of the front layers, then turn over sideways.

18. Indian Country is finished. If you wish you can slide a piece of blue paper in between the layers to add some sky.
