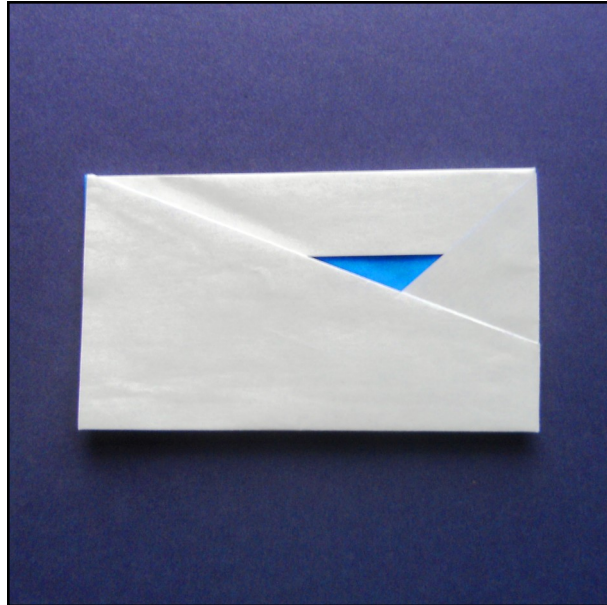


# Llyn Dhu

Designed by David Mitchell

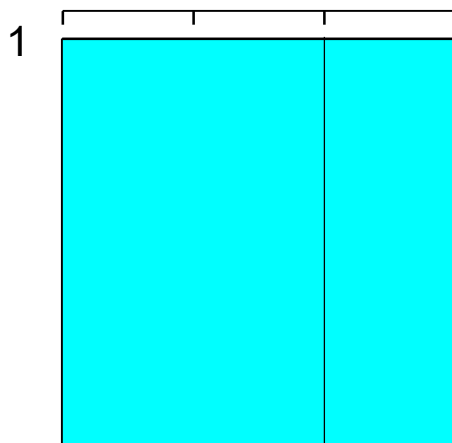
Llyn Dhu is one of a series of pictorial landscape designs. I once used it as a Christmas card design under the title Sea Amid the Winter Snow.

With a little practice you will be able to fold Llyn Dhu by making folds 4 and 5 as judgement folds and by using the top of the right hand mountain to locate the fold in step 8. When made in this way, Llyn Dhu is just a four fold design.

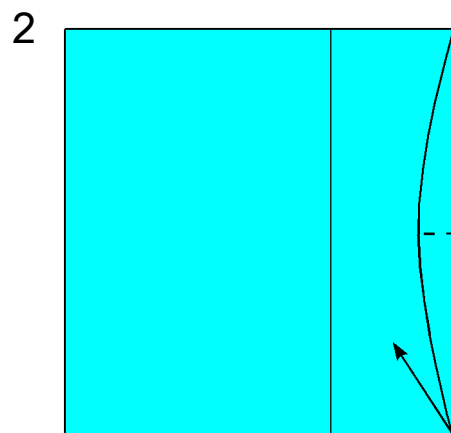


Llyn Dhu was designed in 2002.

You will need a single square of irogami, dark blue / white for preference. Begin with your paper arranged coloured side up.

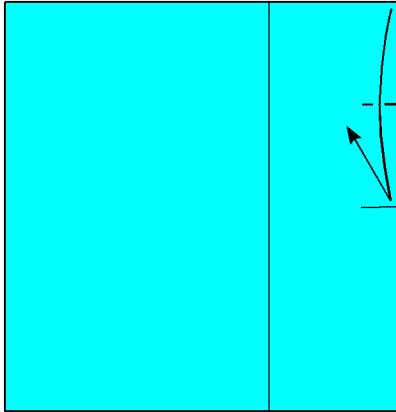


1. Make a vertical crease one third of the way across the paper .



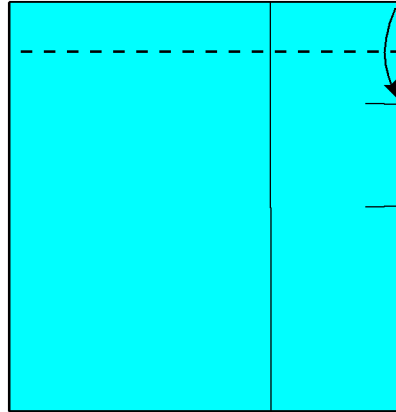
2. Make a tiny crease to mark the centre of the right hand edge.

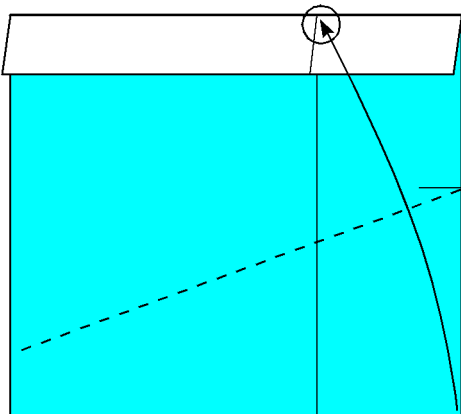
3. Make a second tiny crease to mark the quarter way point.

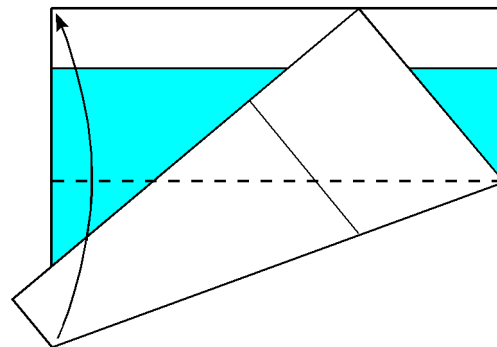
4. Fold the top edge downwards using the quarter way point to locate the fold.

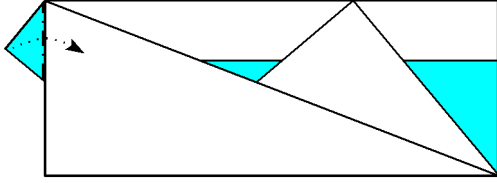
5. Fold the bottom right hand corner onto the point marked with a circle where the crease made in step 1 intersects the top

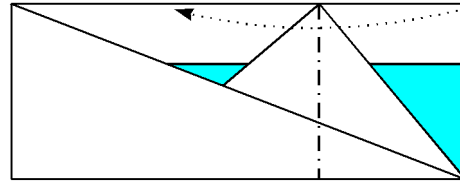
6. Fold the bottom left hand corner onto the top left hand corner.

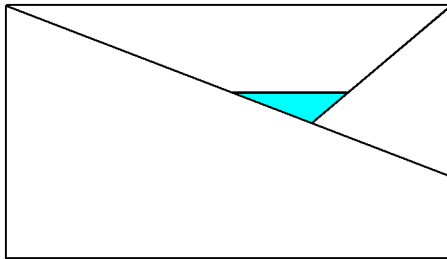
7. Fold the coloured triangular flap backwards out of sight.

8. Fold the right hand part of the sketch backwards out of sight using the line of weakness created by the crease made in
