


Naive Hound


Naive Hound was designed in 2013.



You will need two squares of paper. Any kind of paper can be used.


Folding Piece 1


1. If you are using irogami arrange your paper white side up. Fold in half sideways, then unfold.


2. Fold both lower sloping edges inwards to lie on the vertical crease.


3. Fold the top point downwards along the line of the top edge of the front layers.

4. Fold the bottom point upwards to just touch the bottom point of the front layer.



5. Piece 1 is finished.


Folding Piece 2


6. Begin by following steps 1 and 2 of the instructions for Piece 1. Fold the top point downwards along the line of the top edge of the front layers, then unfold.


7. Fold the top point downwards as shown.


8. Fold in half sideways.


9. Fold the top left corner diagonally downwards as shown. Make sure the crease starts from the point where the crease made in step 6 intersects the left edge.


10. Make sure that edge xx is parallel to edge yy. Adjust if necessary. Unfold.


11. Crimp the head inside the body using the existing creases.

12. Open out sideways.



13. Piece 2 is ready for assembly.


Putting the pieces together


14. Insert Piece 1 inside Piece 2 like this.


15. Make sure the vertical creases in both pieces are correctly aligned. Fold the bottom point of Piece 2 upwards along the line of the bottom edge of Piece 1. This will lock the two pieces together.


16. Fold about three-quarters of the bottom front flap downwards to create the tail.


17. Fold in half sideways, allowing the head to move back into its original place as you do so.

18. Rotate 90 degrees clockwise.

19. Naive Hound is finished.

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
