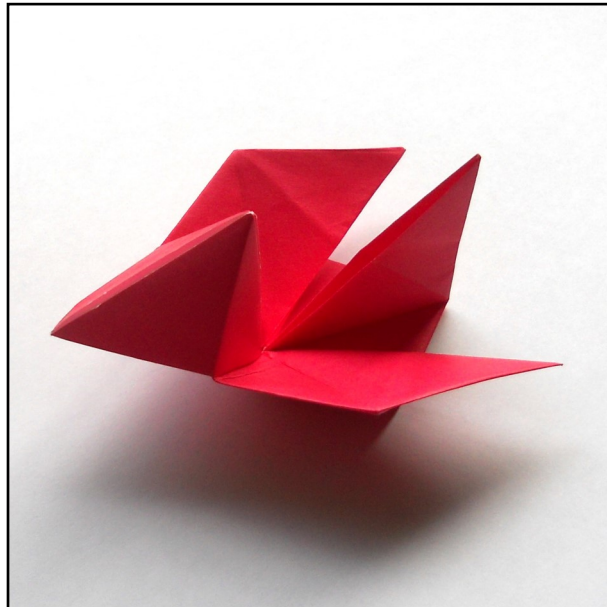


Cocotte in Flight / Pajarita in Flight

The Cocotte in Flight / Pajarita in Flight design is a simple transformation of the traditional Cocotte / Pajarita achieved in just one simple move, by turning the whole design inside out.

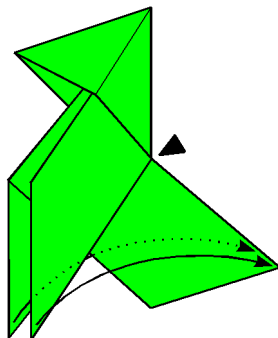
One of the things that gives me the greatest pleasure in paperfolding design is looking for, and occasionally finding, simple adaptations like this.



I found this adaptation in 2020.

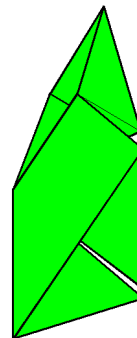
Begin by folding a standard Cocotte / Pajarita from a square of paper. If you are using irogami blintz your square first so that the head is the same colour as the body.

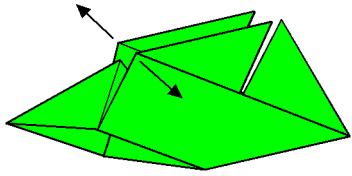
1. Flip the design inside out like this and flatten to look like picture 2.

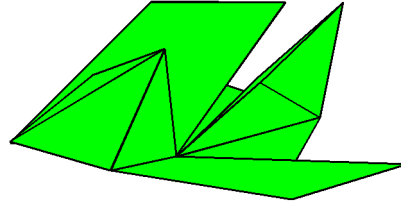
2. Flatten all the creases carefully then rotate 90 degrees anticlockwise.

3. Pull the wings apart and allow the design to assume the shape shown in picture 4.

4. Cocotte in Flight / Pajarita in Flight is finished. The original Cocotte / Pajarita is barley recognisable in this form.
