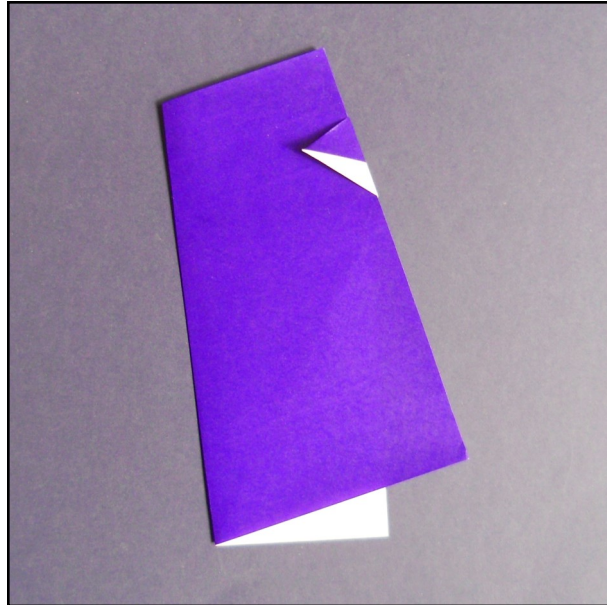


Easter Islander / Nefertiti

Easter Islander and Nefertiti are two closely related designs, one from an A4 or similar rectangle and one from a square. Easter Islander is made using just two active folds and Nefertiti using just four. Nefertiti is also a surprise denouement design.

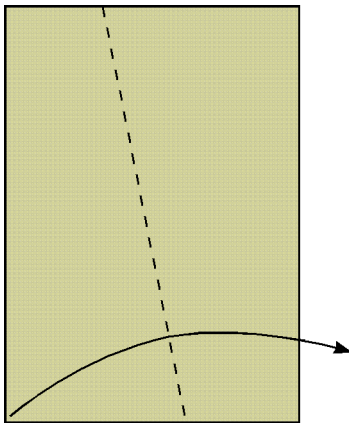
Easter Islander was designed in 1993 and Nefertiti in 2011.



Easter Islander

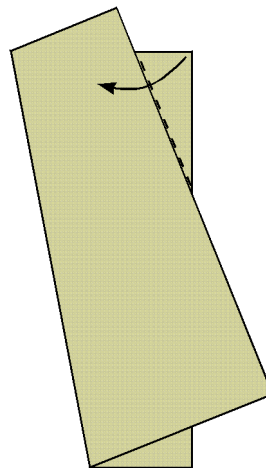
You will need a sheet of A4 photocopy paper or any other rectangle of paper of similar proportions which is the same colour both sides.

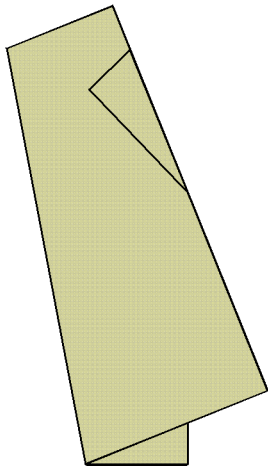
1. Fold the left hand edge across to the right so that the result looks like picture 2.

2. Fold the top right hand point of the rear flap to the front..

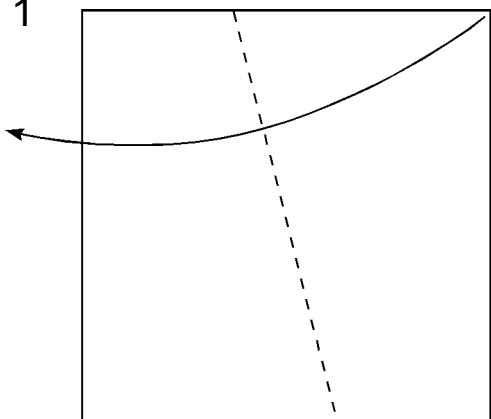


3. Ideally the front flap should spring slightly upwards towards you to allow its shadow to emphasise the outline of the eye. Easter Islander has been finished in just two folds.

Nefertiti

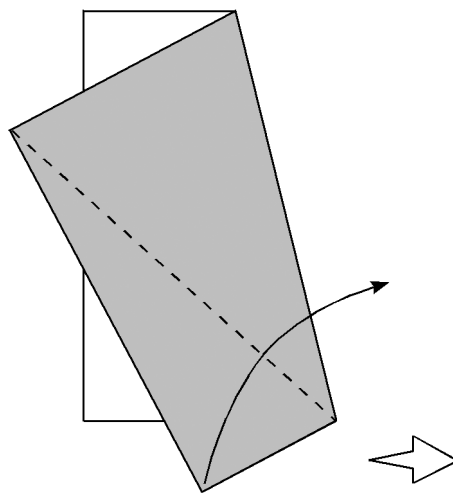
You will need a square sheet of irogami. Begin with your paper arranged white side up.

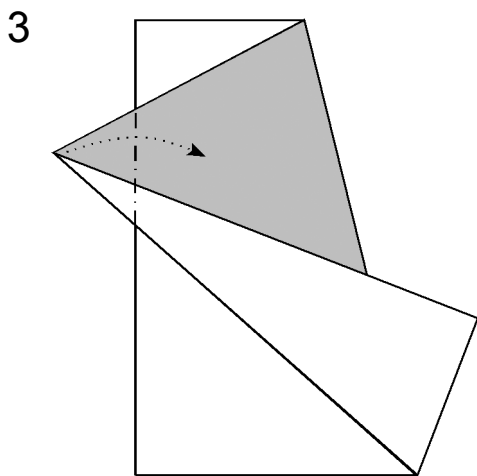


1. Fold in half sideways as shown. Ideally the crease should go through the centre of the square.

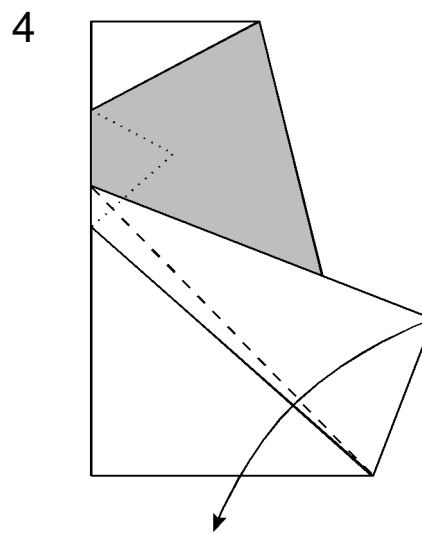

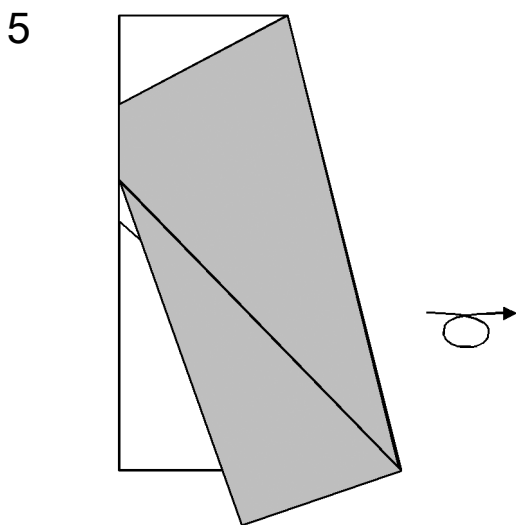
2. Ideally all four single layer areas of paper should be the same size and shape. Fold the bottom corner of the front layer upwards to the right.



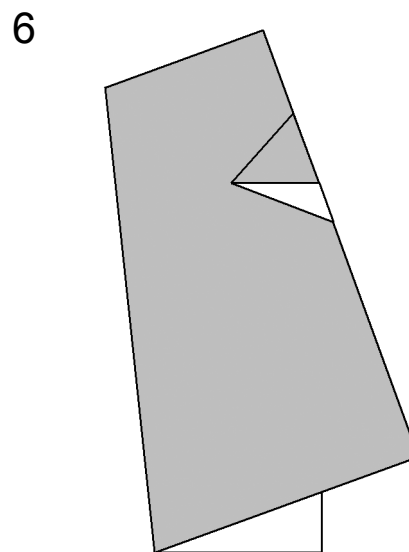
3. Fold the left hand corner backwards out of sight behind the other layers.



4. The dotted line shows the position of the hidden flap. Fold the front flap downwards as shown.



5. Turn over sideways and rotate slightly to look like picture 6.



6. Nefertiti is complete.

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
